



Columbus State University has partnered with the Maneuver Captains Career Course (MCCC) since 2012 in providing graduate education in parallel with MCCC. As graduate education is critical to the professional and personal development of commissioned officers, this partnership enables officers to leverage their attendance at Professional Military Education into realizing their goal for completing their master's degree earlier in their career than previously possible. This opportunity comes in two forms. First is the MCCC Scholars Program which provides full time civilian education for up to six months upon completion of MCCC. The Part Time Program has no resident full-time schooling requirement but provides the opportunity to complete the degree online at the officer's follow-on duty location.

Applications can be found at the link below. Soldiers must complete an application, submit ALL transcripts. Once at Ft. Moore we will fill out their military fee waiver. All these documents must be submitted to the CSU contact Haley Wilson. Contact information is listed at the bottom of this document.

MCCC Scholars Program

The scholar's program will be comprised of up to 10 MCCC students who the Army selects. They will spend 6 months taking in person classes to complete their graduate degree with special projects/designated course of studies in one of 3-degree plans MSOL, Strategic Communication, or MPA.

MSOL

- 30 hours (10 classes total)
- MCCC gives you 9 hours (3 classes) transfer credit
- You must complete 21 hours (7 classes) for degree

Strategic Communication

- 30 hours (10 classes total)
- MCCC gives you 9 hours (3 classes) transfer credit
- You must complete 21 hours (7 classes) for degree

MPA

- 36 hours (12 classes total)
- MCCC gives you 9 hours (3 classes) transfer credit
- You must complete 27 hours (9 classes) for degree

Part Time Program

The program can be offered in a variety of ways, online, in person, and hybrid. Open to all active-duty Captain Career Course (CCC) graduates. 9 credit hours transferred from CCC. The remaining courses can be taken in person or online depending on your next duty station. Officers will be able to take 1-2 classes in person (at night or weekend) or online while in MCCC at Ft. Moore.

MSOL

- 30 hours (10 classes total)
- Any Active Duty CCC gives you 9 hours (3 classes) transfer credit
- You must complete 21 hours (7 classes) for degree

- 30 hours (10 classes total)
- MCCC gives you 9 hours (3 classes) transfer credit
- You must complete 21 hours (7 classes) for degree

MPA

- 36 hours (12 classes total)
- MCCC gives you 9 hours (3 classes) transfer credit
- You must complete 27 hours (9 classes) for degree
