

#### INTERNATIONAL STUDENT SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP

## **GUIDELINES AND INFORMATION**

## What do I get?

The ISSS scholarship reduces your out-of-state tuition costs to in-state tuition. This is an approximate cost savings of \$3,500 - \$6,500 per semester (graduate/undergraduate).

## What do I have to do?

Maintain a 3.0 grade point average and perform 25 service hours per semester. Half of the hours should be performed by the mid-term of the semester to avoid probabtion.

- Failure to perform 20 or more hours by the end of the semester may result in a loss of the scholarship.
- Failure to achieve all 25 hours, but more than 20, will result in probation for the next semester.
- Failure to achieve all hours after a probation status <u>will</u> result in the loss of the scholarship.
- Only one probation semester is allowed while on the ISSS.

## How do I earn hours?

Approved CGE opportunities for service:

- <u>International Student Orientation (up to 5 hours)</u> Assisting with International Student Orientation can earn you up to 5 hours before the semester even begins. Orientation takes place the week before classes begin.
- World at Reach Program (1-3 hours) International students give presentations/talk about their home countries and cultures in classes at CSU or in the Columbus community
- <u>International Club (1 hour per event/meeting)</u> International and internationally-minded students come together to plan events that are both social and educational in nature and oversee organizational meetings aimed at bringing U.S. and international students together.
- <u>International Education Week (Fall semester) (up to 5 hours)</u> During this week, international students will help coordinate and implement a variety of events and activities to help celebrate and highlight the importance of international education
- Global Dialogues (1 hour per event) The Global Dialogues Forum is a series of roundtable discussions between international and U.S. students about current and

- relevant world topics. International students act as table moderators and direct the conversation.
- <u>CSU Day of Service (up to 4 hours)</u> This is an annual event for a team of students who participate in service activities.
- Other (1 hour per event) International and cultural activities at CSU that foster internationalization of the campus
- <u>CGE Duties (up to 4 hours)</u> Assisting in the Center for Global Engagement office when needed

You can receive up to 5 hours total for any event that is <u>ongoing for a set number of days</u> (Fri., Sat., Sun., for example).

Attending an event <u>does not</u> mean that you will be given hours. Service means assisting with the event.

# ANY ACTIVITY THAT IS <u>NOT CGE-SPONSORED</u> <u>MUST RECEIVE PRIOR APPROVAL</u> TO BE CONSIDERED.

- IF WE EMAIL YOU AN EVENT OPPORTUNITY, CONSIDER IT APPROVED.
- BUT YOU MUST HAVE A SERVICE FORM SIGNED BY THE SITE SUPERVISOR OR PERSON IN CHARGE OF THE EVENT AND RETURN THAT TO CGE TO RECEIVE HOURS.
